This dates back to the 8th Century. The pub today was built in the 11th Century. The name is the result of cock fighting taking place in the main bar in the late 19th and early 20th Century. A lovely, old English pub to visit.

ST ALBANS CLOCK TOWER

The clock tower is an example of medieval belfry. The people of St Albans built the tower between 1403 and 1412 as a symbol of resistance against the power of the abbot of St Albans, The 600 year old bell and tower stands opposite the Abbey and provides breathtaking views of Herts.
